VERB OR NOUN ?



A verb is an action word. It tells us what someone or something does.

Example: I eat an apple. (eat = verb) / The dog runs fast. (run = verb)

A noun is a word that names a person (teacher), a place (school), a thing (ball), or an animal (dog).
