## ARTICLES: A, AN, THE



What are Articles? Articles are small words (a, an, the) that come before nouns. They help us talk about things clearly!

"A" - Use before singular nouns starting with consonant sounds (a cat, a dog)

"AN" - Use before singular nouns starting with vowel sounds (an apple, an owl)

"THE" - Use when talking about a specific thing that both people know about (the sun, the cake we eat), or when something is mentioned for the second time in a story


